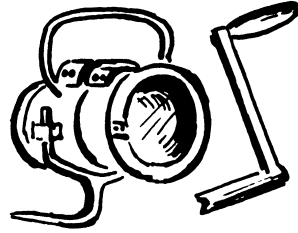
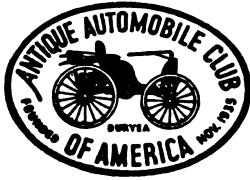

September 16 – 19, 2022 – Microtel, Bath NY 1-607-269-8062

FRIDAY: Scenic drive for about 4 hours, including a 30-minute rest stop, from lot at Hamburg Cracker Barrel, 21 Industrial Drive, Hamburg, to the Corning Glass Museum <https://home.cmog.org/>. Lunch at the Museum café, tour the Museum. Dinner at the Chat-A-Whyle in Bath. Check-in at the Microtel, Bath.

SATURDAY: Short drive to Hammondsport, tour Glenn Curtiss Museum, shuttle to Depot Park for the Wings and Wheels event <https://wingsandwheelshammondsport.com/> or optional trip to Bully Hill Winery <https://www.bullyhillvineyards.com/> featuring tastings, café, gift shop, wine museum and a gorgeous overlook of Keuka Lake and the airshow. Dinner at the Chat-A-Whyle.

SUNDAY: One-hour scenic drive to the Finger Lakes Welcome Center in Geneva <https://www.iloveny.com/listing/finger-lakes-welcome-center/127758/>. CRITERIA: (As was originally established in 2005) Any student beginning his/her second year of education beyond high school or vocational school, to attend a college or trade school of their choice will be considered for Education Monies from the Ontelaunee Region. The same student may be considered for a grant in his/her third or fourth, if they did not receive any past grants or there are no other candidates applying for the money in their Second Year. The determination shall be made by the Education Committee at the time the application is received. Any child or grandchild of an active member of the Ontelaunee Region may apply for this education money. Maximum award is \$500 per applicant.
