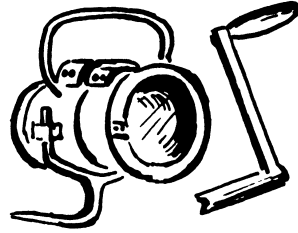
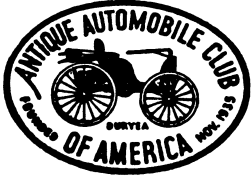

FRIDAY: Scenic drive for about 4 hours, including a 30-minute rest stop, from lot at Hamburg Cracker Barrel, 21 Industrial Drive, Hamburg, to the Corning Glass Museum <https://home.cmog.org/>. Lunch at the Museum café, tour the Museum. Dinner at the Chat-A-Whyle in Bath. Check-in at the Microtel, Bath.

SATURDAY: Short drive to Hammondsport, tour Glenn Curtiss Museum, shuttle to Depot Park for the Wings and Wheels event <https://wingsandwheelshammondsport.com/> or optional trip to Bully Hill Winery <https://www.bullyhillvineyards.com/> featuring tastings, café, gift shop, wine museum and a gorgeous overlook of Keuka Lake and the airshow. Dinner at the Chat-A-Whyle.

SUNDAY: One-hour scenic drive to the Finger Lakes Welcome Center in Geneva <https://www.iloveny.com/listing/finger-lakes-welcome-center/127758/>. Rest lakeside, have lunch on Seneca-Cayuga canal boat ride. Next, Muranda Cheese Co. <https://www.murandacheese.com/> for cheese tasting and country rock band, or Idol Ridge <https://idolridge.com/> for a tasting or something non-alcoholic on their huge patio overlooking Seneca Lake. MONDAY: 1.5 hour docent-led tour of the Finger Lakes Boating Museum's <https://www.flbm.org/> collection of fine wooden boats. Lunch at Stephanie's then home to PA.

DISCOVERING THE TWIN CHURCHES OF EASTERN BERKS COUNTY

How many Protestant churches were started in Berks County as more than one congregation? Most of them. On June 12, 2022, 14 members of the Ontelaunee AACA took some time out of their busy schedules to see what these churches look like today. Several have built a second building. However, there was one dual church still alive.

Our journey began at Zion's Church, Windsor Castle. First, we attended the contemporary service. Pastor Randy Bond acknowledged the club and told stories about the church's history. Next, we drove by Gernants, Maiden creek, Trinity Bible Fellowship, Spies Evangelical UCC and Lutheran, and Bethany Lutheran while touring the back roads around Leesport, Oley, and Mt Penn.

Before finding our way through the city's edge, we made a pit stop at the Reading Pagoda. We ran into a lovely couple from the Bronx. They were gracious to take this photo.



From Skyline Drive, we passed Albright College on our way to the Cross on the Hill behind Alsace Churches: Grace Alsace and Alsace Lutheran. Cheri told a few stories of growing up in this congregation and why the cross was there. Pastor Emeritus Reverend Charles E. Fair requested a place for people to pray for the city of Reading.

Due to weather conditions, we canceled the picnic lunch scheduled for Gring's Mill and had a time of fellowship at Crossroads Restaurant. The schedule change added

two bonus churches onto our tour, Holy Guardian Angels and Christ United. Everyone in attendance remarked about the wildlife we encountered: a whitetail deer whose tail was black and a family of groundhogs.

Thank you, everyone, for making our first tour a success.
